Device Concept

The remote control has the same functionality as the power source's control panel. A precise description of the possible settings can be found in the power source's Operating Instructions.


NOTE!

To be able to use the remote control, the welding system must have a TPS/i power source.



Controls, connections and indicators

Keys and Symbols



(1) Control dial with rotary/push button function

For selecting elements, setting values and scrolling through lists

(2) Special function button

For selecting special functions depending on configuration

(3) Gas-test button

For setting the required amount of gas on the gas pressure regulator. After pressing the gas-test button, gas is emitted for 30 seconds. Pressing the button again ends the process early

- (4) Touch display
- (5) Wire-threading button

For threading the wire electrode into the torch hosepack without gas or current

(6) Wire-return button


For retracting the wire electrode without gas or current

NOTE!

Only retract the wire electrode a small amount at a time, to avoid the wire electrode becoming entangled during retraction.

(7) Reading zone for TPS/i Key Card and TPS/i Key Fob

For locking/unlocking the remote control using the TPS/i Key Card and TPS/i Key Fob




- (8) Pivoting mounting and positioning bracket
- (9) USB port
 For connecting USB flash drives (service dongle, license key, etc.)

Installation and Startup


Mount Remote Control on a Handle Tube
