Software Subscription: annual software fee

What is the software subscription (annual software fee) for WeldCube Premium?

With the annual software subscription our customers receive the following services:

- / Several times per year, there are new software releases always providing several new functions and possibilities. Every customer paying the annual software subscription fee will get those updates automatically and can use them at any time.
- / With this software subscription we sustainably ensure this ongoing development at Fronius.
- / Customers with software subscription will benefit from full API functionality of WeldCube Premium
- / The fee is included free of charge during the first year after license purchase and will then be charged annually.

Customer benefits

- / The customer always uses the latest software version and is thus always up-to-date.
- / Profiting from new functions immediately without additional investment costs.
- / Full web API functionality.



What happens, if the customer does not pay the annual software subscription?

- / The customer won't receive any updates. This means that he will get
 - / NO new functions & NO bug fixing
 - / NO API functionalities
- / If a customer still wants to use the last version of the software at a later date, he must buy the updates later. The price for this is calculated individually per customer on request and depends on how many years he has not paid a subscription. The maximum amount charged is the new value (gross sales price) of the software (4,080,001) and Client Access (4,067,011) licenses installed at the customer's site according to the currently valid price list

How to calculate the annual fee

The annual fee is 22% of the gross list price of the software licenses:

- / WeldCube Premium License (4,080,001)
- / WeldCube Client Access Licenses (4,067,011)

It will be charged annually.

WHY do we charge an annual software subscription?

A customer might tell you: "...this is a money printing machine for Fronius..."

→ No, it is not, because:

- / It is nowadays no longer possible to finance software development based on one-off payments because ongoing further development is a must-have today. This is what we finance and ensure based on the annual fee.
- / Even regular operating system updates e.g. Microsoft launches regularly and which are defined as safety updates require that we also keep on developing WeldCube Premium further.
